- · Repainting and wallpapering throughout



In the foyer/stairway, the hardwood floors were refinished along with the installation of moldings and wainscoting to the staircase wall and throughout. Spindles were replaced for a more substantial architectural look. The wall leading to the foyer from the kitchen was opened up to create an open

line of vision from the foyer and formal dining area. In the dining room, faux columns and half walls were removed to open up the space. Built-in china cabinets with accent lighting were installed along with new wallpaper and elegant chandelier.



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The layout changes made the master suite more accessible from the kitchen via a butler's pantry complete with a coffee bar. The homeowners can now prepare their coffee only a few steps away from the bedroom. The elegant butler's pantry stores extra items and creates additional workspace for prep-work,



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

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
