room. Bring a sample of the material you are trying to match with you when you visit your local retailer, so they can help you with paint choices. Color chips may look different in the showroom compared to your home and may even change throughout the day, depending on your lighting. Color samples are available to 'try on' or apply directly to your walls, allowing you to live with and experience color before making your purchase.

**Decide what your desired finish** 

will be. For the finish, you need to consider whether you want to achieve a flat, eggshell, satin, or semi-gloss look. When painting over a drastically darker or lighter color, invest time and money in a primer. It can help reduce the number of paint coats required to achieve the desired look. Consult your local retailer for help in selecting the right primer.

Go for the Green. Great strides are being made in technology to make paint environmentally friendly by lowering its VOC's (Volatile Organic Compounds) and make compliant coatings that perform as well or better than ordinary paint. One of the main advantages of these waterborne products is low odor as well as non-yellowing, faster drying time and easy cleanup. Inquire of your retailer how these products can fit with your project.


